

## **BURNED KITTEN GETS SECOND CHANCE AT LIFE**

A 9-week-old kitten is currently receiving care at the Humane Society for Tacoma & Pierce County for severe burns.

TACOMA, WA – On June 22, a 3-week-old kitten at the time was brought to the Summit Veterinary Referral Center by Tacoma Animal Control with severe burns.

Once the kitten, now called Hobbes, was in stable condition, he was transferred to the Humane Society for Tacoma & Pierce County, where he is currently receiving care.

Hobbes arrived with burns on his toes, chest, and the top of his right ear. The most severe burn wound covered his back with raw skin, crusted edges, and oozing pus.

The shelter's veterinary staff changed his bandages and applied burn cream daily for the last four weeks. They are managing his pain with medication, and avoiding infection with antibiotics. The shelter's veterinary staff recently

performed surgery to close the open wound on Hobbes' back and placed a drain to avoid infection.

Hobbes is now recovering in a foster home and will need continued medical care to properly heal and manage his pain.
