44 DOGS FROM ALLEGED ANIMAL CRUELTY INVESTIGATION TO BECOME AVAILABLE FOR ADOPTION



TACOMA, WA — On October 15, the Humane Society for Tacoma & Pierce County took in 36 adult and puppy pit bulls as the result of an ongoing animal cruelty investigation in Tacoma's backyard.

Yesterday, the 36 dogs and puppies, along with eight additional puppies who were born in the shelter's care, have been released into the care of the Humane Society for Tacoma & Pierce County by Pierce County Animal Control.

Following spay/neuter surgeries and additional standard medical care for all 44 pups, the dogs will become available for adoption. We start accepting adoption applications today.

Ranging from just a few weeks old to 5 years old, all the dogs have been friendly, loving, and sociable since

arriving at the shelter.

Any prospective adopter will have to fill out an application and will have a comprehensive background check conducted on them by Pierce County Animal Control.

If you are interested in adopting one of the dogs, please fill out an <u>application</u> and <u>background</u> <u>check authorization form</u> and email it to <u>adoptions@thehumanesociety.org</u>. This email is currently being used to process adoption applications only for these pit bulls.

Please note: All individuals aged 18 and older in your household must complete an <u>additional</u> <u>background check authorization form</u>.
