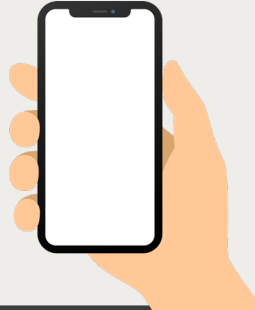
Walk the animal around the area.

Most pets don't wander far from home! If it's a dog, walk it around the area. Alert neighbors and ask if they know where the pet belongs.

Spread the word.

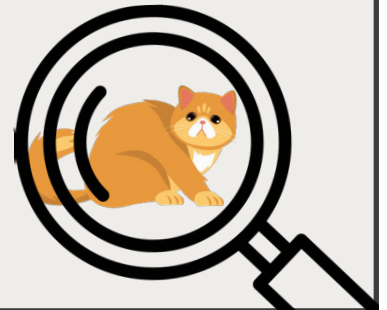
Post photos of the pet and location information on local lost pet Facebook groups, Nextdoor, and other online resources.

Check for tags and microchips.

If the pet has tags, call their owner to set up a reunion. If the pet does not have a tag, take them to a local vet clinic, pet store, or shelter to have them scanned for a microchip.

File a found pet report.

File a found pet report on our website! The information you provide about the pet will be posted on our website's "Found Animals" page within 48 hours of submitting the form.

Hold on to the pet.

Become a Friendly Finder and provide a temporary home for the found pet. If you can care for the pet in your home, their family will have an easier time getting them back if they stay in the neighborhood they were found.
