

## TACOMA ANIMAL SHELTER UPDATES PUBLIC HOURS

TACOMA, WA – As of Jan. 1, the Humane Society for Tacoma & Pierce County has changed its hours of operation to the public. The shelter is now open daily from 11:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. with the Adoption Center closed on Mondays.

From Tuesday to Sunday, anyone interested in adopting can visit the shelter's adoptable pets. Adoptions will continue to be first-come, first-served. The public still has access to lost and found services, end of life services, and microchipping at the shelter's Animal Receiving area seven days a week.
