The Humane Society for Tacoma and Pierce County to host Subaru Loves Pets and the ASPCA® & Subaru Event Grant Program

Who: The Humane Society for Tacoma and Pierce County, in partnership with Bruce Titus Subaru and the ASPCA

What: The Humane Society for Tacoma and Pierce County, in partnership with Bruce Titus Subaru and ASPCA, will be offering 50% off adoption fees for all senior dogs ages 7 years and up, as well as all adult cats age 1 year and up. In addition, Good Neighbor Vet will be onsite with a mobile clinic to provide low cost vaccines, microchips, nail trims and more between the hours of 10 AM and 1 PM.

Where: Our event will take place at the Humane Society for Tacoma and Pierce County, near the corner of Center St and S Pine St. The address is 2608 Center St, Tacoma, WA 98409

When: The event will take place during normal Saturday business hours, which are 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. It is suggested that any media arrive before opening due to high volume of potential adopters usually being lined up before we open.

Why: Our goal for this event is to promote the adoptions of senior dogs, ages 7 and up, as well as adult cats 1 year or older. Senior dogs unfortunately are often overlooked by potential adopters in favor of younger dogs due to their age. Adult cats, like senior dogs, are also often overlooked during kitten season. We believe that age should never be a disqualifier when considering adoption as older pets have just as much love to give as younger pets.
