

If You Have Lost a Pet...

Visit Our Shelter

Searching the shelter at least every other day is the best way to find your lost pet. A staff member will escort you through the found pet kennels. There are also Found Pet Logs that list descriptions of found pets that are not on view - they may be at a veterinary clinic, in a quarantine or isolation area, or in the home of a Good Samaritan who found them.

Photos and descriptions of found pets currently at the shelter are listed on our website and updated daily.

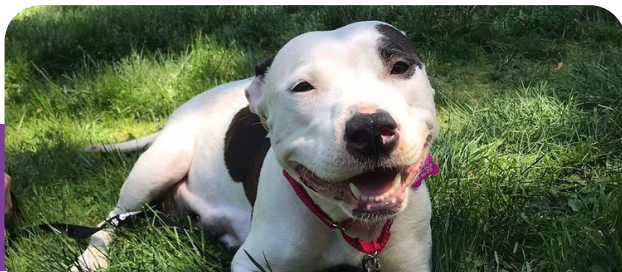

Get Out in Your Community

Talk to as many people as you can in your neighborhood, or the area where your pet was lost. Some neighborhoods have a "neighborhood watch" email distribution list and may be willing to send out an alert.

Create Signage

Post signs in the area with a description and a photo of your lost pet.



Upload photos of your missing dog or cat. Petco Love Lost immediately scans to determine whether the lost pet is at a participating shelter or with a neighbor in the community.

Petco Love Lost is a national database of lost and found pets that uses patented pet facial recognition technology to bring pets back home. It's free, fast, and easy to use.

Low Cost Microchips

The Humane Society for Tacoma & Pierce County offers low-cost pet microchips to the public with national registration.

No appointment necessary. The procedure takes only a minute and can be done anytime from 11:00 am - 5:30 pm, seven days a week.
